REGISTER EARLY! There are 2 options for registration! You can register online at **rpiconference.org** or download a registration form from the website and mail it. *We prefer online registration.* You can register and pay online—or register online and mail your payment to avoid the 3.5% convenience fee for using your credit card. Registration forms have also been mailed to each RP congregation (ask your pastor or clerk of session). For those using a paper registration form, please include the grades of your children from K-12th grade. To answer your questions, there is a **Q&A** page on the website. **Registration closes on May 15, 2024!**

Lodging Info: Options for lodging include: 1) *Standard Dorm Suites*, which are 2 bedrooms (2 beds each) sharing a bathroom; 2) *Two- and Three-Bedroom Lodge Suites*, with each bedroom containing 2 beds, living room, and kitchenette; 3) *Four-Bedroom Dorm Suites*, which contain 4 bedrooms with 2 beds each, living room, and 1 large bathroom. (Options 2 and 3 are available first to large immediate families, and then first-come, first-served.) When choosing family housing, one person should request the suite, and all other people in the family should select "In a suite requested by someone else on this form." You may have someone not in your immediate family stay with you, but they must pay the single person rate.

<u>High School Housing</u>: The conference houses high school students together with counselors in separate dorms, providing unique opportunities for learning, serving, and fellowshiping with each other.

Lodging for married couples: The lowest-cost lodging option for a married couple with no children is to request 2 "single person, shared occupancy." The lodging cost for 2 would be \$284. If you prefer a private dorm suite (not sharing the bath with another couple), request 2 "single person, single occupancy." Lodging cost for 2 would be \$484. *These costs do not include the meals and program fee.*

Deposit/Payments: A nonrefundable \$50 deposit must be paid at the time of your online registration or within 10 days of registration if you mail your check. There is a **3.5% convenience fee to use a credit/debit card or 1% fee for ACH/bank** transfer to pay your registration. **Full payment must be received by June 1, 2024.**

<u>Airport Transportation</u>. Bus transportation will be available to and from the Indianapolis International Airport. On Tues., June 25, one bus will leave the airport for IWU at 2 PM and one bus at 6 PM. On Mon., July 1, the bus will leave IWU at 9 AM for the airport. Fees are \$25 one way/\$50 roundtrip per person (children under 12 free). **Note:** Email the registrars to make a reservation for the bus.
